



PRESS RELEASE

It is for the information of all aspirants of the Competitive Examination for Engineering cadre for the post of Assistant Executive Engineer/ Assistant Engineer (i. Civil/ ii. Mechanical/ iii. Electrical/Electronics & iv. Chemical) BPS-17, in Public Health Engineering and Rural Development Department, Irrigation Department, Education Works, School Education Department, Works & Services Department and Sports and Youth Affairs Department, Government of Sindh Advertised through Adv: No. 04/2020, 05/2021, and 06/2022. The said advertisements were issued during 2019 to 2022 but the process of recruitment could not be finalized due to Covid-19 and Commission being non-functional on the orders of Honourable High Court of Sindh, Circuit Bench Hyderabad. As the said examinations are pending for last three years, if separate written examination is conducted for each category and Department it will take considerable time and resources to complete the process.

Keeping in view the precious time of aspirants it is decided to conduct an integrated / combined examination so that aspirants can appear in all exams by appearing only once. Therefore, the said examination is scheduled to be conducted in the month of February 2023.

It is important for candidates / aspirants to be cognizant of the process to be carried out through integrated / Combined activity. All aspirants who have applied in respective Departments will have to appear in General Compulsory papers only once and will be considered for all categories. On the other hand, they will have to appear in Professional compulsory papers of concerned Departments, whereas aspirants have to appear only once in optional papers if they have opted same optional papers in all Departments. However, those who have opted for different optional papers for the posts in different Departments will have to appear in each optional paper. In this regard, Information Technology Section of SPSC will issue a comprehensive/detailed admission letters with clarity of compulsory/ Professional compulsory and optional papers along with dates and time.

Most importantly, the result for each category of all Departments will be announced separately thus if any candidate failed to appear in any of the General Compulsory he / she will be considered absent in all categories. Similarly if any candidate fails to appear in Professional Compulsory or Optional papers for concerned Department will be considered absent in respective Department. Therefore, candidates / aspirants who have applied in different Departments have to appear in all papers mentioned in their admission letters.

Furthermore, a separate desk for proper guidance and resolving of queries regarding said examination is being established at Enquiry office, Head Office, Sindh Public Service Commission Hyderabad. Therefore, all aspirants are requested to comprehend the process fully and feel free to contact/ visit the designated desk at Enquiry office, SPSC Hyderabad.

Last but not the least, no any claim / excuse will be accepted in case any candidate fails to appear in any of the paper on the pretext of confusion or unintelligibility.
